

TUITION

Tuition for the program is \$900.00 for Chamber Members and \$1200.00 for Non-Chamber Members. Tuition covers all program costs, materials, meals, and lodging.

Graduates of our program include physicians, school principals, mothers of newborns, chief executive officers, government employees and many other heavily-scheduled professionals. Before applying, it is critical that you commit to your fullest to making each session a priority.
